There were no declarations of interest.

Standing Orders. The Chair proposed the following amendment be made. Amendment to Standing Orders to allow a vote by Secret Ballot for co-option of a new Community Councillor(s) and for other matters at the discretion of the Council and/or Chairperson. This to take immediate effect. This was agreed by all.

To co-opt a Community Councillor. Two letters received showing an interest. Following a secret ballot and following Co-option of a Community Councillor procedures Aled Williams, Ystrad, Talylychau, was elected as Community Councillor. Clerk to notify Candidates by letter of the result.

Appointment of Churchyard/Burial Clerk. As no interest received it was agreed to send a letter to the Vicar Tim Nelson as it is understood he had shown an interest and if so to let us know in writing by the 31st October, 2021.
