Matters arising.

Community Field. Due to the deterioration and safety it was agreed to dismantle the Pagoda and all the play equipment and burn on site. This to be carried out by members. It was agreed to see if any grants available to plant Willow trees in the wet area of the field. To be discussed again next meeting.

The Old Ash Tree. Further to reply received by the Council last month. E-mail received from Angie Hastilow advising that she has spoken to the Tree Safety Officer for Carm. C.C. and had received the same reply as the Council, that he had come to see it in August, and confirmed it is doing well. He will be coming back again next month to check it again.
