Matters arising.

Defibrillator Training. Jane Morgan will continue to contact St. John's re dates for Training.

Talley Playground Committee. Following meeting held on the 19th April 2023 at Ysgol Talylychau letter received from Claire on behalf of the committee thanking and appreciating the time spent by the Council meeting with them. They will keep us updated on progress with the site visits from the Council approved playground providers.

It was agreed to purchase under Section 137. £120 worth of bunting for the benefit of the Community inhabitants of Talley - to be put up and taken down by Volunteers.
