There were no declarations of interest.

Matters arising.

Removal of portable toilets and picnic table on field owned by Carms. C.C. was discussed.

Defibrillator Checks and Training. E-mail received from Emily advising that all 3 defibs have been checked and no issues to report. Emily advised that the Information that the British Heart Foundation give to those checking defibrillators mentions that Althea should each have a razor and a pair of scissors. This is to aid gaining access to the patient’s chest. Jane Morgan will discuss further with Emily.

E-mail received from Wayne Edwards from St John Ambulance Cymru advising that he could arrange a 2 hour CPR and Defibrillator Awareness Session and this would be free of charge.
